

## TRIFOLD Data Inserts – Fort Gillem

### Importance for the Community

- The Army is engaged with the Forest Park/Fort Gillem Local Redevelopment Authority (FPFGLRA) to complete the redevelopment planning process.
- If approved, approximately 722 acres of land and real property will be transferred to the FPFGLRA. The FPFGLRA has proposed a light industrial redevelopment plan for the land and real property.
- The remaining property will be sold by the Army to developers who would agree to enter into a development agreement with the LRA specifying how the property would be developed in accordance with the community's vision.

### Importance for the Army

- Annual recurring savings of \$35.3 million beginning 2012.
- The closure of Fort Gillem, an administrative installation, allows the Army to employ excess capacities at installations that can accomplish more than administrative missions. The closure of Fort Gillem also enables the stationing of its tenant units at locations that will increase their ability to associate with like units, promote coordination of efforts and improve training opportunities with operational forces.
