

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) FOR THE CLOSURE, DISPOSAL, AND REUSE OF THE COURCELLE BROTHERS UNITED STATES ARMY RESERVE CENTER, RUTLAND, VERMONT

The U.S. Army Reserve 99th Regional Support Command and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers prepared an EA to analyze the potential environmental impacts that could result from the proposed closure, disposal, and reuse of the Courcelle Brothers U.S. Army Reserve Center at 16 North Street Extension in Rutland, Vermont. The closure of the Courcelle Brothers USARC follows the recommendation of the Base Closure and Realignment (BRAC) Commission.

The EA was made available for a 30-day public comment period on December 13, 2011. The comment period has been extended due to a technological error that affected the online availability of the EA.
