

## **ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) FOR THE CLOSURE, DISPOSAL, AND REUSE OF THE JAMES W. REESE UNITED STATES ARMY RESERVE CENTER, UPLAND, PENNSYLVANIA**

The U.S. Army Reserve 99<sup>th</sup> Regional Support Command and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers prepared an EA to analyze the potential environmental impacts that could result from the proposed closure, disposal, and reuse of the James W. Reese U.S. Army Reserve Center at 500 West 24<sup>th</sup> Street in Upland, Pennsylvania. The closure of the Reese USARC follows the recommendation of the Base Closure and Realignment (BRAC) Commission.

The EA was made available for a 30-day public comment period on December 16, 2011. The comment period has been extended due to a technological error that affected the online availability of the EA.
