

NOTICE OF 30-DAY COMMENT PERIOD FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

The Department of the Army proposes to transfer approximately 7.7 acres from the SFC Nelson V. Brittin United States Army Reserve Center, Pennsauken, NJ to the Pennsauken Township's Office of Emergency Management for use as offices in the administrative building, vehicle use in the maintenance shop, and the construction of a silo for salt storage. In compliance with Section 120(h) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, the Army has prepared a draft Finding of Suitability for Transfer (FOST) in support of this project. It is the intent of the Army to sign the FOST in order to facilitate the property transfer.
