Items being accepted

Non-perishable pre-packaged foods Fruit bars, granola bars, cookies, non-melting candy (M&M's), powdered drink mixes (e.g., Gatorade, iced tea, Kool Aid, lemonade, coffee, tea, hot chocolate mix), instant creamer, sugar, hot sauce, ketchup, mustard, liquid flavor ice pops, chewing gum, beef jerky, Twizzlers, Tootsie Roll pops, bubble gum, Skittles, Life Savers, Sweet Tarts, peanuts, pretzels, potato chips, dried fruit snacks, trail mix, Slim Jims, raisins, pop tarts, cereal, peanut butter, peanut butter crackers, cheese crackers, shelf stable milk.

DIRECTIONS

By Car

From NJ Turnpike

Take Exit 13A or 14 "Newark International Airport". Coming into the airport property, follow blue 'hotel' signs to the Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located on the left side of the oval directly in front of Terminal B.

From Garden State Parkway

Northbound: Take Exit 140 to US Route 22 East, travel 4 miles to US Routes 1 & 9 South. Bear left to Airport entrance. Follow blue 'hotel' signs to the Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located on the left side of the oval directly in front of Terminal B.

Southbound: Take Exit 142 to NJ Route 24 East/I-78 and proceed to US Routes 1 & 9 South. Bear left to Airport entrance. Follow blue 'hotel' signs to the Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located on the left side of the oval directly in front of Terminal B.

From George Washington Bridge

Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 14 or 13A "Newark International Airport". Coming into the airport property, follow blue 'hotel' signs to the Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located on the left side of the oval directly in front of Terminal B.

From NYC/Holland Tunnel

Take I-78/New Jersey Turnpike Extension to NJ Turnpike South to Exit 14 or 13A "Newark International Airport". Coming into the airport property, follow blue 'hotel' signs to the Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located on the left side of the oval directly in front of Terminal B.

From NYC/Lincoln Tunnel

From Brooklyn/Staten Island

Take I-278. Cross Verrazano Narrows Bridge in Brooklyn and Goethals Bridge in Staten Island to NJ Turnpike North. Take Exit 13A "Newark International Airport". Coming into the airport property, follow blue 'hotel' signs to the Marriott Hotel. The hotel is located on the left side of the oval directly in front of Terminal B.

On-site parking fee – special event rate \$5.00 for the day.

By Air - Newark Liberty International Airport

Hotel shuttle picks up from all terminals every 15 minutes

Terminal A: from Baggage Claim, take escalator down to parking level A. Walk through the vacant underground lot to the street curb. Look for green and white sign that reads 'Newark Airport Marriott Hotel'.

Terminal B: From Baggage Claim, take the escalator down one level and follow the exit sign. Cross the street and look for the sign that says '#5 Newark Airport Marriott Hotel'.

Terminal C: From Baggage Claim, walk toward the exit sign and go outside. Cross the street to the second island and walk to your right past the taxi stand. Stand under sign #7 'Shared Ride Services'.
