1. THIS MILPER MESSAGE SUPERSEDES REFERENCE C AND WILL EXPIRE 30 SEPTEMBER 2013.

2. THE DEPLOYMENT EXTENSION INCENTIVE PAY (DEIP) PROGRAM IS AN ACTIVE ARMY INCENTIVE PROGRAM (NOT TO INCLUDE RESERVE COMPONENT SOLDIERS ON ACTIVE DUTY) DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE ENLISTED SOLDIERS WHO DO NOT INTEND TO REENLIST, TO VOLUNTARILY EXTEND THEIR SERVICE IN ORDER TO COMPLETE A DEPLOYMENT WITH THE UNIT TO WHICH THEY ARE CURRENTLY ASSIGNED.

3. ELIGIBILITY. THE DEIP PROGRAM MAY BE OFFERED TO ENLISTED SOLDIERS ASSIGNED TO DEPLOYING UNITS IN ORDER TO MEET UNIT READINESS REQUIREMENTS AS DETERMINED BY THE FIRST COLONEL (O6) COMMANDER IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND. SOLDIERS WHO DO NOT EXTEND FOR THE DEIP PROGRAM WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TIME FRAMES OF PARAGRAPH 4 BELOW ARE SUBJECT TO EARLY SEPARATION IAW REFERENCE D ABOVE. SOLDIERS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

A. ASSIGNED TO A UNIT DESIGNATED FOR DEPLOYMENT IN SUPPORT OF OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM (OEF), TO INCLUDE PROFESSIONAL FILLER SYSTEM (PROFIS) SOLDIERS IDENTIFIED TO DEPLOY WITH A UNIT.

B. FULLY ELIGIBLE AND QUALIFIED FOR DEPLOYMENT.

C. FULLY ELIGIBLE AND QUALIFIED FOR REENLISTMENT/EXTENSION AS OUTLINED IN PARAGRAPH 3-8, AR 601-280.

D. HAVE AN EXPIRATION TERM OF SERVICE (ETS) ON OR AFTER THE UNIT'S LATEST ARRIVAL DATE (LAD) AND BEFORE THE UNIT'S PROJECTED REDEPLOYMENT+90 (R+90) DATE.

E. VOLUNTARILY EXTEND THEIR CURRENT SERVICE COMMITMENT (ETS) THROUGH THE UNIT'S PROJECTED R+90 DATE.

F. HAVE NOT SUBMITTED ANY PAPERWORK TO REENLIST OR EXTEND THEIR CURRENT SERVICE COMMITMENT.

G. SIGN A WRITTEN AGREEMENT TO DEPLOY AND SERVE THROUGH THE UNIT'S PROJECTED R+90 DATE USING DA FORM 1695, VOLUNTARILY EXTENDING THEIR CURRENT SERVICE COMMITMENT TO MEET THIS SERVICE REMAINING REQUIREMENT (SRR).

H. DEPLOY WITH THE UNIT TO WHICH THEY ARE ASSIGNED.

I. THE FOLLOWING SOLDIERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR DEIP:

(1) SOLDIERS SERVING ON AN INDEFINITE ENLISTMENT OR NOT ELIGIBLE FOR REENLISTMENT/EXTENSION.

(2) SOLDIERS WITH AN APPROVED VOLUNTARY RETIREMENT DATE.

(3) SOLDIERS WITH A MANDATORY RETIREMENT DATE (MRD) ON OR AFTER THE UNIT'S LAD AND PRIOR TO R+90.

(4) SOLDIERS WITH AN ETS PRIOR TO THE UNIT'S LAD.

(5) SOLDIERS THAT WILL EXCEED THE RETENTION CONTROL POINT (RCP) FOR THEIR CURRENT GRADE PRIOR TO R+90.

(6) SOLDIERS THAT DO NOT EXTEND FOR ENOUGH TIME TO MEET THE UNIT'S PROJECTED R+90.

(7) SOLDIERS THAT DO NOT COMPLETE A DEIP EXTENSION WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TIME FRAMES OF PARAGRAPH 4 BELOW.

4. TO ALIGN THE DEIP PROGRAM WITH THE ENLISTED INVOLUNTARY EARLY SEPARATION PROGRAM, DEIP WILL BE MODIFIED AND EVENTUALLY ELIMINATED AS INDICATED BELOW:

A. FOR UNITS DEPLOYING WITH A LAD THROUGH 31 JANUARY 2013, THE DEIP PROGRAM MAY BE OFFERED TO SOLDIERS BEGINNING 9 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE UNIT'S LAD. INDIVIDUAL SOLDIERS WILL HAVE UNTIL 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THEIR CONTRACTUAL ETS (ETS-90) TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.

B. FOR UNITS DEPLOYING WITH A LAD BETWEEN 01-28 FEBRUARY 2013, THE DEIP PROGRAM MAY BE OFFERED TO SOLDIERS BEGINNING 9 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE UNIT'S LAD. INDIVIDUAL SOLDIERS IDENTIFIED IAW PARAGRAPH 3 ABOVE WILL HAVE 90 DAYS FROM NOTIFICATION OF DEPLOYMENT TO ACCEPT/DECLINE PARTICIPATION IN THE DEIP PROGRAM.

C. FOR UNITS DEPLOYING WITH A LAD BETWEEN 01 MARCH AND 31 MAY 2013, THE DEIP PROGRAM MAY BE OFFERED TO SOLDIERS BEGINNING 9 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE UNIT'S LAD. INDIVIDUAL SOLDIERS IDENTIFIED IAW PARAGRAPH 3 ABOVE WILL HAVE 45 DAYS FROM

NOTIFICATION OF DEPLOYMENT TO ACCEPT/DECLINE PARTICIPATION IN THE DEIP PROGRAM.

D. FOR UNITS DEPLOYING WITH A LAD OF 01 JUNE 2013 OR LATER, THE DEIP PROGRAM WILL NOT BE OFFERED.

E. NO DEIP CONTRACTS WILL BE EXECUTED AFTER 31 JANUARY 2013.

5. THE DEIP INCENTIVE WILL BE AUTHORIZED AS FOLLOWS:

A. IAW PARAGRAPH 4A ABOVE, UNITS WITH A LAD THROUGH 31 JANUARY 2013, SOLDIERS WHO EXECUTE THEIR EXTENSIONS FOR THE PURPOSES OF DEIP BETWEEN 9 MONTHS PRIOR TO LAD (LAD-270) AND 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO LAD (LAD-180) WILL RECEIVE \$500 PER MONTH FOR EACH FULL MONTH THEY EXTEND THEIR SERVICE COMMITMENT. SOLDIERS WHO EXECUTE THEIR EXTENSIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEIP AFTER LAD-180 AND BEFORE ETS-90 WILL RECEIVE \$350 PER MONTH FOR EACH FULL MONTH THEY EXTEND THEIR SERVICE COMMITMENT.

B. IAW PARAGRAPH 4B AND 4C ABOVE, UNITS WITH A LAD ON OR AFTER 01 FEBRUARY THROUGH 31 MAY 2013, SOLDIERS WHO EXECUTE THEIR EXTENSIONS FOR THE PURPOSES OF DEIP WITHIN SPECIFIED TIME FRAMES WILL RECEIVE \$500 PER MONTH FOR EACH FULL MONTH THEY EXTEND THEIR SERVICE COMMITMENT.

C. IAW PARAGRAPH 4D ABOVE, UNITS WITH A LAD ON OR AFTER 01 JUNE 2013, THE DEIP PROGRAM WILL NOT BE OFFERED.

6. EXCEPTIONS:

A. UNITS THAT ARE NOTIFIED FOR DEPLOYMENT OUTSIDE OF THE TIME FRAMES SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH 4 ABOVE MAY REQUEST AN EXCEPTION FROM COMMANDER, US ARMY HUMAN RESOURCES COMMAND (HRC) TO OFFER THE \$500 TIER INCENTIVE TO THEIR SOLDIERS FOR UP TO 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF NOTIFICATION. SEND REQUESTS VIA EMAIL TO [THE RETENTION AND RECLASSIFICATION BRANCH, AHRC-EPF-R, HRC, FT KNOX](#).

B. SOLDIERS REQUIRED TO REENLIST FOR THE INDEFINITE REENLISTMENT PROGRAM (SSG AND ABOVE WITH 10 OR MORE YEARS OF ACTIVE FEDERAL SERVICE) ARE AUTHORIZED AN EXCEPTION TO POLICY AND ARE ELIGIBLE TO EXTEND UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS MESSAGE.

7. LAD SHIFTS, LAD CANCELLATIONS, DEPLOYMENT EXTENSIONS, AND EARLY RETURN FROM THEATER:

A. SHOULD A UNIT'S LAD OR RETURN DATE CHANGE BY LESS THAN 30 DAYS (SHIFT RIGHT OR SHIFT LEFT), THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES TO DEIP EXTENSIONS CURRENTLY IN PLACE.

B. SHOULD A UNIT'S LAD OR RETURN DATE CHANGE BY AT LEAST 30 DAYS AND NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS TO A LATER DATE (SHIFT RIGHT):

(1) SOLDIER MAY REQUEST CANCELLATION OF EXTENSION PRIOR TO UNIT'S LAD. ONCE THE UNIT HAS DEPLOYED, ALL DEIP EXTENSIONS REMAIN FIRM; NO CANCELLATIONS ARE AUTHORIZED.

(2) SOLDIER MAY VOLUNTARILY REQUEST AN ADDITIONAL DEIP EXTENSION TO MEET THE NEW DEPLOYMENT TIMELINE.

(3) SOLDIERS WHO ELECT NOT TO REQUEST AN ADDITIONAL DEIP EXTENSION WILL CONTINUE TO SERVE ON THE ORIGINAL EXTENSION AND RECEIVE THE AUTHORIZED MONTHLY INCENTIVE LEVEL UNLESS A CANCELLATION OF EXTENSION IS APPROVED BY HRC. THESE SOLDIERS WILL BE REDEPLOYED NLT 90 DAYS PRIOR TO ETS TO ALLOW TIME FOR TRANSITION.

C. SHOULD A UNIT'S LAD OR RETURN DATE CHANGE BY AT LEAST 30 DAYS AND NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS TO AN EARLIER DATE (SHIFT LEFT):

(1) SOLDIER MAY REQUEST CANCELLATION OF EXTENSION PRIOR TO UNIT'S LAD. ONCE THE UNIT HAS DEPLOYED, ALL DEIP EXTENSIONS REMAIN FIRM; NO CANCELLATIONS ARE AUTHORIZED.

(2) SOLDIER MAY REQUEST ADJUSTMENT OF HIS/HER DEIP EXTENSION TO COINCIDE WITH THE ADJUSTED R+90 DATE. SOLDIER WILL RECEIVE THE INCENTIVE LEVEL AS DESCRIBED UNDER THE ORIGINAL DEIP AGREEMENT.

(3) SOLDIERS WHO ELECT NOT TO REQUEST AN ADJUSTMENT OF THEIR DEIP EXTENSION WILL CONTINUE TO SERVE ON THE ORIGINAL EXTENSION AND RECEIVE THE AUTHORIZED MONTHLY INCENTIVE LEVEL UNLESS A CANCELLATION OF EXTENSION IS APPROVED BY HRC. SOLDIERS WILL ONLY RECEIVE DEIP PAYMENTS FOR THE MONTHS FROM CONTRACTUAL ETS TO R+90.

D. SOLDIERS WHO WERE INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN DEIP BASED ON THE ORIGINAL LAD BUT ARE NOW ELIGIBLE DUE TO THE SHIFT IN LAD MAY REQUEST TO VOLUNTARILY EXTEND THEIR ENLISTMENT PROVIDED THEY MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH 3 ABOVE AND TIME FRAMES OUTLINED IN PARAGRAPH 4.

E. SHOULD A UNIT'S DEPLOYMENT BE CANCELLED OR ITS LAD CHANGED BY MORE THAN 180 DAYS EARLIER (SHIFT LEFT) OR LATER (SHIFT RIGHT), ALL DEIP AGREEMENTS MUST BE CANCELLED NLT 90 DAYS FROM DEPLOYMENT CANCELLATION OR LAD SHIFT.

F. SHOULD A UNIT'S DEPLOYMENT BE EXTENDED WHILE IN THEATER, SOLDIERS SERVING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF DEIP MAY REQUEST AN ADDITIONAL EXTENSION TO COMPLETE THE DEPLOYMENT PLUS 90 DAYS. SOLDIER WILL RECEIVE INCENTIVE LEVEL AS DESCRIBED UNDER THE ORIGINAL DEIP AGREEMENT. SOLDIERS WHO ELECT NOT TO REQUEST AN ADDITIONAL DEIP EXTENSION WILL CONTINUE TO SERVE ON THE ORIGINAL EXTENSION AND RECEIVE THE AUTHORIZED MONTHLY INCENTIVE LEVEL; THESE SOLDIERS WILL BE REDEPLOYED NLT 90 DAYS PRIOR TO ETS TO ALLOW TIME FOR TRANSITION.

G. SHOULD A UNIT OR INDIVIDUAL DEPLOYMENT BE CURTAILED WHILE IN THEATER (SOLDIERS/UNIT RETURN TO HOME STATION EARLIER THAN THEIR ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED REDEPLOYMENT DATE), THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH 9 APPLY. SOLDIERS WHO REDEPLOY EARLY MAY VOLUNTARILY REQUEST AN ADJUSTMENT TO THEIR ETS NOT TO EXCEED 90 DAYS FROM HRC APPROVAL DATE OR PREVIOUS CONTRACTUAL ETS DATE WHICHEVER IS LATER (AS APPLICABLE). IN THIS CASE, SOLDIERS WILL ONLY RECEIVE DEIP PAYMENTS THROUGH R+90.

8. DEIP PAYMENTS:

A. SOLDIERS ELIGIBLE FOR DEIP WILL BE PAID MONTHLY.

B. PAYMENTS WILL BEGIN AT ETS OR LAD, WHICHEVER IS LATER. SOLDIERS WILL ONLY RECEIVE DEIP PAYMENTS FOR MONTHS SERVED ON THE EXTENSION WHILE IN THEATER AND

FOR MONTHS SERVED ON THE EXTENSION BETWEEN RETURN AND R+90 DAYS.

C. DEIP PAYMENTS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED FOR ANY PERIOD OF THE DEIP EXTENSION SERVED PRIOR TO LAD OR FOR ANY PERIOD OF THE DEIP EXTENSION THAT CAUSES THE SOLDIER TO SERVE BEYOND R+90 DAYS.

D. ALL DEIP AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS MESSAGE WILL BE HONORED IAW POLICES IN PLACE AT THE TIME OF EXTENSION. DEIP AGREEMENTS EXECUTED ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS MESSAGE MUST BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS MESSAGE OR WILL BE CONSIDERED ERRONEOUS.

E. NO DEIP CONTRACTS WILL BE EXECUTED AFTER 31 JANUARY 2013.

F. PORTIONS EARNED WHILE SERVING IN A COMBAT ZONE TAX EXCLUSION (CZTE) AREA ARE TAX-FREE.

9. SOLDIERS WHO EXTEND FOR DEIP BUT SUBSEQUENTLY ARE UNABLE TO DEPLOY MAY CANCEL THEIR EXTENSIONS VOLUNTARILY, REGARDLESS IF THE UNIT HAS DEPLOYED AND PROVIDED THEY HAVE NOT BEGUN SERVING ON THE EXTENSION. SOLDIERS WHO EXTEND FOR DEIP BUT SUBSEQUENTLY ARE UNABLE TO DEPLOY WHO DO NOT CANCEL THEIR EXTENSION MAY SERVE THE EXTENSION, BUT THEY WILL NOT NORMALLY BE ELIGIBLE FOR DEIP PAYMENTS. UNDER THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES, THE UNPAID PORTION OF DEIP WILL BE PAID IF A SOLDIER IS UNABLE TO DEPLOY WITH THE UNIT TO WHICH THE SOLDIER IS ASSIGNED, DEPLOYS LATE, OR RETURNS EARLY FROM DEPLOYMENT:

A. THE SOLDIER DIES THROUGH NO MISCONDUCT OF THEIR OWN;

B. THE SOLDIER INCURS AN INJURY OR ILLNESS IN THE LINE OF DUTY IN A COMBAT ZONE DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT OR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, OR IN A COMBAT-RELATED OPERATION DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, AND IS SEPARATED OR RETIRED FOR A DISABILITY DESCRIBED UNDER CHAPTER 61 OF TITLE 10, U.S. CODE AND/OR A COMBAT-RELATED DISABILITY AS DEFINED UNDER SECTION 1413A(E) OF TITLE 10, U.S. CODE; OR

C. IT IS DETERMINED, ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS, THAT TO REFRAIN FROM PAYING OR CONTINUE PAYING THE UNPAID PORTION OF DEIP WOULD BE CONTRARY TO AN ARMY PERSONNEL POLICY OR MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVE, AGAINST EQUITY OR GOOD CONSCIENCE, OR CONTRARY TO THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE UNITED STATES. THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE THIS DETERMINATION RESTS WITH THE FIRST COLONEL (O6) COMMANDER IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND, IAW REFERENCE A. THIS AUTHORITY MAY NOT BE FURTHER DELEGATED. DETERMINATIONS MADE UNDER THIS AUTHORITY WILL BE REPORTED THROUGH ESTABLISHED RETENTION CHANNELS TO [THE RETENTION AND RECLASSIFICATION BRANCH, AHRC-EPF-R, HRC, FT KNOX](#) WHO WILL NOTIFY HQDA RETENTION (DAPE-MPE-PD).

10. RESPONSIBILITIES:

A. BRIGADE COMMANDERS OR THE FIRST COLONEL (O6) COMMANDER IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND:

(1) ASSESS THE UNIT'S ABILITY TO MEET DEPLOYMENT PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS BASED ON THE NUMBER OF SOLDIERS, BY MOS AND GRADE, THAT DO OR DO NOT HAVE ETS DATES THROUGH R+90.

(2) DETERMINE THE NECESSITY TO AUTHORIZE DEIP PARTICIPATION TO ALLEVIATE

PERSONNEL SHORTFALLS.

(3) APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE DEIP PROGRAM PARTICIPATION FOR SPECIFIC UNIT IDENTIFICATION CODES (UIC) IN MEMORANDUM FORMAT BASED ON UNIT MISSION AND READINESS REQUIREMENTS. THIS AUTHORITY MAY NOT BE DELEGATED.

B. BATTALION COMMANDERS:

(1) ENSURE ALL ELIGIBLE SOLDIERS AUTHORIZED BY THE FIRST COLONEL (O6) COMMANDER IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND RECEIVE COUNSELING FROM THE UNIT CAREER COUNSELOR ON THE BENEFITS OF EXTENDING UNDER THIS PROGRAM.

(2) IDENTIFY SOLDIERS WHO VOLUNTARILY EXTENDED FOR DEIP AND DID NOT RECEIVE THE MONETARY INCENTIVE. REFER THESE SOLDIERS TO THE UNIT CAREER COUNSELOR TO RESOLVE ANY DISCREPANCIES.

(3) IDENTIFY SOLDIERS WHO ARE NO LONGER ENTITLED TO DEIP BECAUSE THEY ARE NO LONGER DEPLOYABLE (PROCESS EXCEPTIONS IAW PARAGRAPH 9 ABOVE). THESE SOLDIERS MUST BE REFERRED TO THE UNIT CAREER COUNSELOR FOR TERMINATION OF THE DEIP INCENTIVE.

C. UNIT COMMANDERS: COMMANDERS AT ALL LEVELS SHOULD ENCOURAGE ELIGIBLE SOLDIERS AUTHORIZED BY THE FIRST COLONEL (O6) COMMANDER IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND TO EXTEND UNDER THE DEIP PROGRAM AS REQUIRED TO ENHANCE UNIT READINESS.

D. CAREER COUNSELORS: ENSURE ALL SOLDIERS ARE COUNSELED ON THE BENEFITS OF AN EXTENSION UNDER DEIP. ADDITIONALLY, CAREER COUNSELORS WILL:

(1) SERVE AS THE COMMANDER'S SUBJECT MATTER EXPERT (SME) ON DEIP.

(2) FORWARD AUTHORIZATION MEMORANDUMS, SIGNED BY THE FIRST COLONEL (O6) COMMANDER IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND TO [THE RETENTION AND RECLASSIFICATION BRANCH, AHRC-EPF-R, HRC, FT KNOX](#) PRIOR TO EXECUTING DEIP EXTENSIONS.

(3) SERVE AS THE UNIT POC FOR ALL PAY ISSUES PERTAINING TO DEIP. REPORT TO HRC SOLDIERS WHO DID NOT RECEIVE DEIP PAYMENTS AND SOLDIERS WHO ARE NO LONGER ENTITLED TO DEIP PAYMENTS.

(4) MONITOR UNIT'S LAD AND REPORT ANY CHANGES TO [THE RETENTION AND RECLASSIFICATION BRANCH, AHRC-EPF-R, HRC, FT KNOX](#).

(5) ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE FOR CAREER COUNSELORS WILL BE PUBLISHED VIA RETAIN MESSAGE.

E. HRC (AHRC-EPF-R) WILL PROVIDE DFAS A MONTHLY ROSTER OF SOLDIERS WHO HAVE EXTENDED FOR DEIP, THE TIER LEVEL (\$500 OR \$350) THEY ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE, AND THE MONTH(S) IN WHICH PAYMENT(S) WILL BE EXECUTED. ADDITIONALLY, HRC IS THE APPROVAL AUTHORITY FOR ALL CANCELLATIONS OF DEIP EXTENSIONS.

11. SOLDIERS EXTENDING UNDER THE DEIP PROGRAM CONTINUE TO BE ELIGIBLE TO REENLIST IF OTHERWISE QUALIFIED.
